## Chattahoochee Tech Dual Enrollment Program for High School Students

High school students can get a jump start on their college education through the Dual Enrollment program at Chattahoochee Technical College. Through the Dual Enrollment program, these students can earn college and high school credit simultaneously at little or no cost for the student. Dual Enrollment introduces students to college-level coursework and allows for potential career exploration. Dual Enrollment opportunities enhance student engagement, improve graduation rates, and increase student learning.

In order to participate in Dual Enrollment, students must be enrolled in a participating Georgia high school or approved home-study program. Qualifying 11th and 12th graders are eligible to take any approved course. 10th graders are only permitted to take CTAE/Occupational courses and are not allowed to take CORE courses unless qualifying ACT or SAT scores are received. The Georgia Student Finance Commission (GSFC) website at [gafutures.org](http://gafutures.org) provides a list of funding course categories differentiating CTAE and CORE courses. Refer to the Dual Enrollment Course Directory on the GSFC website for a complete list of approved Dual Enrollment courses.

To be accepted into the Dual Enrollment program at Chattahoochee Tech, students must complete the college's online Dual Enrollment Admission Steps by the applicable Dual Enrollment deadlines. Dual Enrollment deadlines differ from traditional students applying to the college after high school graduation. Please visit the Chattahoochee Tech website for more information at: <https://www.chattahoocheetech.edu/dedeadlines/> High school students are permitted to take up to 15 credit hours per semester in the Dual Enrollment Program. Dual Enrollment funding will pay for up to 30 semester credit hours per student. Please note that state legislation is subject to change with respect to Dual Enrollment, a factor which could impact Dual Enrollment participation, eligibility, and funding.

## MC MONTGOMERY COLLEGE

### Dual Enrollment at Montgomery College



Nathan Villiger had no trouble learning most of the subject matter in his home-school curriculum, but he was not confident about his ability to teach himself math. The 17-year-old senior from Gaithersburg enrolled in precalculus and a political science class at the College's Germantown Campus—and thrived. “The first two weeks were definitely an adjustment period,” he says, “but in the end I learned a lot. I think it was a great first exposure to college-level work.”

If you are interested in getting a head start on your college career, then Dual Enrollment may be for you.

Dual Enrollment is an MC academic initiative that allows qualified high school students to be admitted and enrolled at Montgomery College to take credit courses while still completing their high school diploma requirements.

Students enroll in a variety of courses at the college and the credits earned may be applied to a degree program at MC or may potentially be transferred to another institution.

Students can attend Montgomery College courses on campus or online. Need-based financial assistance is also available.

Villiger is enrolled in a calculus class this semester while he waits to hear from four-year schools, including St. Mary's College of Maryland, Dickinson, Gettysburg, Swarthmore, and Haverford. He recommends all home-schooled students take courses at Montgomery College. “When you've been used to flexible deadlines as a home-schooler, you learn quickly about deadlines and due dates in MC classes,” he says. “And MC has more resources—like the math learning center [MAPEL Center]—to help you succeed.”



Not only is Carly Morris set to graduate this year with her high school diploma and an associate's degree in psychology, she's also been accepted with scholarships to all 13 colleges nationwide to which she applied.

How did she do it? By taking college courses in high school through the [dual enrollment program](#) at Montgomery County Community College.

Students, 15-years-old and older, can take classes at one of MCCC's campuses, online or at their high school with trained faculty and earn undergraduate credits. These credits can be transferred to a four-year college or university. Courses are offered in the evenings, on weekends and during the summer.

Morris, an 18-year-old Pottsgrove High School senior, said her journey began after she decided to take an online introductory English course the summer following her sophomore year at Pottsgrove High School.

Christine Morris, Carly's mom, spoke to a friend about her daughter's plan. They suggested she finish an associate's degree before graduating high school, which would really set her up for the future.

The opportunity was too good to pass up.

At MCCC, Morris has been involved both in and out of the classroom. She is a member Phi Theta Kappa, the International Honor Society for Community Colleges, which requires a student to have a GPA of at least 3.5 and earned a minimum of 12 credits at the College. She also is a member of Psi Beta, the Community College National Honor Society in Psychology, and the Psychology Club.

For Christine Morris, choosing MCCC was one of the best things for her daughter's future.

"I can say that Dual Enrollment was the best decision we ever made," she said. "When we first started her dual enrollment classes, we never imagined she would be graduating with her degree from Montco, let alone a month before she graduates high school. 



For homeschooling families of students who learn differently, Landmark College's small class sizes, one-on-one advising, and supports for executive function and social pragmatics have long provided a good option for making the transition to higher education.

### What were you looking for in a college and what attracted you to EMU?

I'm working as a community advisor in the residence halls this year, which has helped me feel more confident as a leader and get to know more people. I'm also in the orchestra and choir as well as taking piano lessons (all with much more enjoyment than skill). During my free time, I can generally be found in one of the campus hammock chairs reading or out exploring the area!

### What advice would you give to other homeschooled students in their college search?

My advice would be to make the most of what makes you different. Colleges that want to prepare students to make a real difference in the world generally get excited about students who are unusual in some way. While I was applying to colleges, when a college wasn't excited about my more unusual education it was generally a good sign that it wouldn't offer the kind of education I wanted. EMU was full of people who were excited to welcome me here!
